On Thursday, December 2nd, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World proposal for Communication 2850. - Communication 2850 unanimously approved with one comment and one contingency:
 - **Comment:** The reviewing faculty would like to express that they were extremely supportive of this course's inclusion within the GE Theme: Citizenship and will be reaching out to the instructor and department to use this as an exemplar.
