On Thursday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Themes: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World proposal for AAAS 3450.

The Panel did not vote on the request as they would like the following feedback points addressed:

- The reviewing faculty are very excited about this course, and strongly supportive of its
  inclusion within the Theme, but request further clarification surrounding how the course
  relates to Citizenship. Specifically, there are concerns that the connection to Citizenship is not
  fully developed within the course syllabus, and would like more of the information in the GE
  Theme submission forms displayed within the course syllabus and ask that the syllabus
  contain more of this information.
- The reviewing faculty ask that further articulation of how weekly topics and readings connect to the GE Theme: Citizenship be provided within the course syllabus.
- The reviewing faculty request clarification around the provided reading list, as it was unclear
  which readings were assigned for which week or when students would be expected to
  complete the readings.

I will return AAAS 3450 to the departmental queue in curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's feedback.
