On Thursday, November 18, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the course proposal for Anthropology 1101. Please find below the Panel's feedback for this course. {N.B. **Contingencies (bolded)** require revision and resubmission to the Panel chair, while *recommendations (italicized)* or comments are suggestions from the Panel that an instructor can implement at their discretion when the course is taught.}

ANTHROPOLOGY 1101 | Unanimously approved with **one (1) contingency** and *two (2) recommendations*

- Contingency: The course schedule should include a bibliography with page numbers for all assigned readings so that students understand workload on a class by class basis.
- Recommendation: The Panel recommends adding a note in the syllabus that this course is worth 3 credit hours.
- Recommendation: On page 2 of the syllabus, the Panel suggests underscoring the fact that there is no required textbook for the course by including this information as a separate statement rather than within a larger paragraph.
