On Tuesday, February 15, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the course proposal for Anthropology 2202. Please find below the Panel's feedback for this course. {N.B. **Contingencies (bolded)** require revision and resubmission to the Panel chair, while *recommendations (italicized)* or comments are suggestions from the Panel that an instructor can implement at their discretion when the course is taught.}

- **The Panel notes that on page 2 of the Distance Approval Cover Sheet, under the 'mode of delivery' section, students can forego the discussion assignment if they attend an optional Zoom discussion session for that week, and "connect in real-time with fellow students and the instructor." This possibility is not reflected in the revised syllabus; the Panel presumes that this language is left over from an earlier iteration of the class. If so, please revise the Cover Sheet and e-mail back to Jeremie Smith (smith.12199). Jeremie will be on the lookout for the revised sheet, and promises a prompt turn around so the course does not get held up.**
