This course offers a synoptic, global history of food, beginning with pre-agricultural societies and ending with today's global food crisis. The course particularly focuses on food systems and their ecological and biological effects. A considerable amount of time in class will be devoted to the question of the sustainability of such systems, from a historical as well as a contemporary perspective. For example, in the lecture on wheat, students are introduced to the late nineteenth-century "wheat crisis" where commentators expressed grave concerns about the impending collapse of the world wheat system (something alleviated by the invention of synthetic fertilizer)
