On Tuesday, January 18, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the course proposal for Education Psychology 2259. Please find below the Panel's feedback for the course.

The Panel did not vote on the proposal as they would like the following points addressed:

- This course appears to be a skills-based class and does not fulfill the requirements for SBS Foundations. However, if the class provides students with a comprehensive overview of theories and methodologies relevant to the social and behavioral sciences, then the Panel is willing to reassess this proposal. If this is the case, when resubmitting, please re-narrate SBS Foundations connections throughout the syllabus, while also underscoring how this focus will not detract from the main mission of the class.

I will return Education Psychology 2259 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.
