On Thursday, March 10th, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel reviewed a new course proposal for Music 3352. Please see the Panel's feedback below:

The Panel did not vote on the proposal for Music 3352, as they would like the following feedback items addressed:

- The Panel thanks the School of Music and the course proposer for the revisions to the proposal. They are unclear how this proposal addresses the Panel's feedback and ask the proposer to reach out to Teresa Johnson.674 at the Drake Institute. Teresa is working with course designers to help implement and create High Impact Practice courses for the new General Education Themes and the Panel believes that she would be an excellent resource to assist in course design.
 - Additionally, the Panel recommends designing this course for in-person delivery first and, after approval at the Themes Panel, submit another request for distance-learning delivery. If the course proposer would like to proceed with the distance-learning request at this stage, they request that the proposer reach out to the ASC Office of Distance Education and speak with an instructional design consultant after working with Teresa Johnson.
