On Thursday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Theme and High-Impact Practice: Service Learning proposal for Music 2032S. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with one contingency and one recommendation. As a reminder, the Panel's contingency must be satisfied in a revision via curriculum.osu.edu while the Panel's recommendation may be implemented when the course is next taught.
