On Tuesday, February 1, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the course proposal for ASC 1411. Please find below the Panel's feedback for this course. {N.B. **Contingencies (bolded)** require revision and resubmission to the Panel chair, while *recommendations (italicized)* or comments are suggestions from the Panel that an instructor can implement at their discretion when the course is taught.}

ASC 1411 | Unanimously approved with one (1) contingency and two (2) recommendations

- Contingency: The Panel requests that on page 2 of the syllabus the language regarding credit hours be adjusted to correspond with a 1-hour course, which for this half-term course should be approximately six hours of work per week.
- Recommendation: The Panel recommends further clarifying the way extra credit operates in the course by creating separate breakdowns for regular points and bonus points to prevent confusion.
- *Recommendation: The Panel recommends providing a suggested guideline for how many modules a student might want to work through each week at minimum.*

I will return ASC 1411 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.
