On Friday, September 30, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World request for History 3561. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

HISTORY 3561 | Unanimously approved with *two (2) recommendations*

- *RECOMMENDATION: The Panel recommends changing the prerequisite of ENGLISH 1110.xx to "completion of GE Foundation Writing and Information Literacy course," as ENGLISH 1110.xx is no longer the only intro-level writing course available to students under the new GE (GEN).*
- *RECOMMENDATION: The Arts and Sciences Curriculum Committee recently approved newly updated standard syllabus statements; the Panel kindly recommends double-checking the syllabus document to ensure that the most current language and information appears for these student resources. For instance, the reviewing faculty note that the SLDS statement on page 9 of the syllabus is not the latest version and suggest revising it accordingly.
