On Thursday, June 9th, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Theme and High-Impact Practice request for Music and Public Health 3010. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

Music and Public Health 3010 were unanimously approved with two recommendations. As a reminder, the Panel's recommendations can be implemented when the course is next taught.

- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend providing a fuller description of the course assignments in the course syllabus to provide students more clear expectations.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend updating the disability statement in the course syllabus (as found on page 5 of the syllabus) to the most up-to-date version.
