Good afternoon,

On Thursday, February 17, the Assessment Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the course proposals for Chinese 2141.02 & 4142.02. Please find below the Panel's feedback for these courses.

The Panel did not vote on the proposals as they would like the following points addressed:

CHINESE 2141.02

- The Panel respectfully requests that more information about the exams be included in the syllabus. How will the exams be conducted? What aspects of language will be tested and in what contexts? Will the tests be multiple choice? Include essays? Spoken and written components? These sorts of details should be specified, especially for an online course.
- Please include all GE goals and ELOs for the World Languages category, which can be found here: <https://oaa.osu.edu/ohio-state-ge-program>. The Panel also recommends including the GE goals and ELOs for the Foreign Language category, since this will go into effect beginning Fall 2022. These can be found here: <https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/general-education-goals-and-expected-learning-outcomes>.
- The Panel recommends adding a mark of E from the grading scale, which appears to be missing in the current version of the syllabus.
- The Panel notes that the location of the course currently says "TBD," and suggests replacing with "Zoom" as the official meeting place.

CHINESE 4142.02

- The Panel respectfully requests that more information about the exams be included in the syllabus. How will the exams be conducted? What aspects of language will be tested and in what contexts? Will the tests be multiple choice? Include essays? Spoken and written components? These sorts of details should be specified, especially for an online course.
- One hour of additional instruction time is needed to meet the credit hour requirements for this course.
- The Panel recommends adding a mark of E from the grading scale, which appears to be

missing in the current version of the syllabus.

I will return Chinese 2141.02 & 4142.02 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.
