Good afternoon,

On Thursday, April 14, the Arts and Humanities Panel 2 of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the course proposal for Philosophy 2540. Please find below the Panel's feedback for this course. {N.B. **Contingencies (bolded)** require revision and resubmission to the Panel chair, while *recommendations (italicized)* or comments are suggestions from the Panel that an instructor can implement at their discretion when the course is taught.}

PHILOSOPHY 2540 | Unanimously approved with **one (1) contingency** and *one (1) recommendation*

- **CONTINGENCY: The Panel asks that the course calendar outline in detail benchmarks and expectations for students on a day-by-day basis (rather than weekly), including specific due dates for any assignments and exams.**
- *RECOMMENDATION: On page 5 of the syllabus, there is a reference to the course as an "online" class; the Panel recommends removing this language, as well as double-checking the syllabus document to edit out any similar discrepancies.*

I will return Philosophy 2540 via curriculum.osu.edu so that the department can address the Panel's requests.
