On Thursday, August 11, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World request for Public Affairs 2150. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

PUBLIC AFFAIRS 2150 | Unanimously approved with **one (1) contingency**:

- **CONTINGENCY:** The reviewing faculty kindly note that only the full and complete GE Goals and ELOs for the Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World theme need to appear in the course syllabus, per a requirement of General Education courses. Specifically, they ask that you add Goals 1 and 2, as well as corresponding ELOs 1.1, 1.2, 2.1, and 2.2, which can be found on the ASCCAS website: <https://ascas.osu.edu/new-general-education-gen-goals-and-elos>. They also ask that you remove the entire Goals and ELOs for the entire General Education Program, which begin on page 1 of the syllabus document.

I will return Public Affairs 2150 to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's feedback.
