On Thursday, April 14, the Arts and Humanities Panel 2 of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the course proposal for History 3676. Please find below the Panel's feedback for this course. {N.B. **Contingencies (bolded)** require revision and resubmission to the Panel chair, while *recommendations (italicized)* or comments are suggestions from the Panel that an instructor can implement at their discretion when the course is taught.}

HISTORY 3676 | Unanimously approved with *three (3) recommendations*

- *RECOMMENDATION: The Panel recommends including further information regarding what the Title IX project entails, possibly adding a trigger warning statement in the assignment description should the content merit one.*
- *RECOMMENDATION: The Panel found the extra credit provisions difficult to decipher, and thus kindly recommends clarifying/rephrasing this section in a way that will prove more accessible to students.*
- *RECOMMENDATION: The Panel suggests that the department include the most up-to-date version of the University's Title IX statement, which can be found here: <https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements>*
