 - On the first page of the syllabus if the official course meeting time for AU22 is still TBD please include a hypothetical placeholder time that indicates how long and how often the class will meet weekly.
 - In the "how your grade is calculated" section of the syllabus, of the 15
 percentage points allotted to TopHat, please designate what the split
 distribution will be between the quizzes and participation subcategories.
 - The Panel requests that the titles of the peer-reviewed articles the students will be expected to read appear on the course calendar.
 - The Panel asks that the date of the final exam also be included on the course schedule.
 - The Panel suggests removing the term "recommended" in regard to the required textbook to ensure student clarity about the materials they need for the course.
 - The Panel notes that the explanatory paragraph outlining how the class intends to meet the goals and ELOs for the Sustainability theme should cover the complete list of goals and ELOs, not just a selection of these points. The Themes Panel will send this back to the department as a contingency, so the Panel strongly recommends that the department make these revisions prior to review at the Themes Panel.
