On Tuesday, May 3, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the proposals for Anthropology 3301 & 5515. Please find below the Panel's feedback for these proposals. {N.B. **Contingencies (bolded)** require revision and resubmission to the Panel chair, while *recommendations (italicized)* or comments are suggestions from the Panel that an instructor can implement at their discretion when the course is taught.}

ANTHROPOLOGY 3301 | Unanimously approved with *two (2) recommendations*

- RECOMMENDATION: On page 2 of the syllabus, after "mode of delivery," the Panel recommends forefronting the fact that the course will be asynchronous with scheduled live sessions, including the specific weekly day(s) and time(s) for the latter.
- RECOMMENDATION: The Panel kindly reminds the instructor to remove the placeholder GE goals/ELOs section on page 2 when finalizing the syllabus that will circulate specifically for Anthropology 3301.

ANTHROPOLOGY 5515 | Unanimously approved with two (2) contingencies

- CONTINGENCY: Does the instructor intend this course to be variable credit hours? The curriculum.osu.edu form has variable 1-3CH selected, but the syllabus indicates the course counts for 1CH. Is the variable credit hours designation on the form correct? If students can indeed enroll in this course for 1-3CH, please demonstrate how the class has the flexibility built into the structure to accommodate this option.
- CONTINGENCY: What percentage must students earn in the course to pass with an S or U? The information on page 5 of the syllabus, under "Grading Scale," should indicate a numerical value that designates a grade of S vs. U.

I will return Anthropology 5515 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.

Anthropology 3301 will continue through the approval process.
