- CONTINGENCY: Please include bibliographic citations for all required books assigned to students.
- CONTINGENCY: On page 3, the Panel asks that the department remove the section referring to masks and social-distancing policy for in-person classes.
- CONTINGENCY: On page 3, the Panel requests that the chart under the "Allocation of Points" subheading distinguish how many of the 100 points allotted to "Class Attendance and Course Engagement" count toward online activities vs. in-class participation.
