On Friday, February 24th, the Themes 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GEN Theme: Lived Environments request for Earth Sciences 2204.

The Panel did not vote on the proposal as they would like to see the following feedback items addressed:

- The reviewing faculty thank the School of Earth Sciences for their revision to the course. While they agree that the course content is certainly suited to fit within the GEN Theme: Lived Environments, they are unable to see how this course will be an advanced study of the GEN Theme. They ask that more information be provided within the course syllabus surrounding course content and what students will be expected to engage with during their class time. For example, how will students receive course content during each individual week? Will there be video lectures from the instructor?
- The reviewing faculty ask that the Student Life – Disability Services statement (as found on pages 10-11 of the course syllabus) be updated to the current version, as the email address provided is out-of-date. - The reviewing faculty request that a cover letter be provided that explains any changes made as a result of the provided feedback.
