Good morning,

On Thursday, July 14th, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World proposal for German 3351. Please see below for their feedback:

German 3351 was unanimously approved with three recommendations:

- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend linking course assignments to individual GE ELOs to help clarify to students how they will be meeting the ELOs for the category.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend correcting, on page 2 of the syllabus, how much the “In-class Exercises” count within a student’s final grade. The percentage is listed as 14% total, but the 2 individual assignments are listed as worth 5% each, for a total of 10% and not 14%.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend updating the Title IX statement, found on page 4 of the syllabus, to the most up-to-date statement. German 3351 will continue through the approval process.
