Good afternoon,

On Tuesday, August 30<sup>th</sup>, the Themes 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GEN Theme: Traditions, Cultures, and Transformations proposals for Comparative Studies 3686. Please see the Panel's feedback below.

The Panel did not vote on Comparative Studies 3686 as they would like the following feedback items addressed in a revision submitted to curriculum.osu.edu:

- The reviewing faculty kindly request that a full bibliography of course readings be provided within the course syllabus. This will allow the reviewing faculty to assess whether this course meets the criteria to be an advanced study course within the Theme category.
- The reviewing faculty kindly request that General Education Theme ELO 1.2 be provided in the course syllabus and a brief rationale be added below the Goals and ELOs that explains how this course will fulfill the GE ELOs. The Goals and ELOs can be found on the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website here: <https://ascas.osu.edu/new-general-education-gen-goals-and-elos>.
- In the GE submission form, ELO 1.2 does not appear to be answered. Please provide an answer to how this course will fulfill GE ELO 1.2 utilizing the most up-to-date GE submission forms, which can be found on the Office of Academic Affairs website at: <https://oaa.osu.edu/ge-course-submission>.
- The reviewing faculty kindly suggest to the department modifying their prerequisite of English 1110 to be "Completion of GE Foundation Writing and Information Literacy course", as English 1110 is not the only writing course available to students to take within the new GE program. Of course, the reviewing faculty recognize that some departments and programs may wish to keep their prerequisite of strictly English 1110 and merely offer this as a friendly suggestion.
- The reviewing faculty ask that a cover letter be provided that details all changes made as a result of the Panel's feedback.

I will return Comparative Studies 3686 to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's feedback.
