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## Good afternoon,

On Monday, October 24th, the Race, Ethnicity, and Gender Diversity Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a course proposal for Sociology 2380.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with two contingencies and two recommendations:

- 1. Contingency: The Panel asks that the department alter the syllabus to more clearly and explicitly connect the assignments to the goals and ELOs of the Race, Ethnicity and Gender Diversity category. While there is some evidence of this connection in the GEN Submission form, the Panel asks that these connections be made more prominent in the syllabus so that students will better understand the focus of the course.
- 2. Contingency: The Panel asks that the department correct the name of the GEN category on the syllabus (pg. 2 under "GEN Course Information") to read: "Sociology 2380 fulfills the General Education Foundation: Race, Ethnicity, and Gender Diversity category."
- 3. Recommendation: The Panel recommends that the department update the Student Life Disability Services statement (pg. 8) to reflect the most recent version of that office's policy. - 4. Recommendation: The Panel recommends that the department update the Mental Health Statement (pg. 8), which has been recently updated with the new phone number for the National Crisis/Suicide Hotline.
