On Wednesday, September 21st, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee review new course proposals for Russian 5260 and Slavic 3340. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

Russian 5260 was unanimously approved with two recommendations:

- **Recommendation:** The Panel recommends removing the outdated and duplicate Title IX statement found on page 12 of the syllabus. The Title IX statement found on page 14 of the syllabus is the most up-to-date one available.
- **Recommendation:** The Panel offers a friendly reminder to ensure that the syllabus, which is an online document for an in-person course, is following the most up-to-date Digital Accessibility policies and recommendations from the university, which can be found on the Digital Accessibility Center's website at: <https://accessibility.osu.edu/>.

Slavic 3340 was unanimously approved.

Russian 5260 and Slavic 3340 will continue through the approval process.
