On Tuesday, October 25th, the Themes 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed new GEN Theme: Migration, Mobility and Immobility requests for Slavic 3340 and 3800. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

Slavic 3340 was unanimously approved with one recommendation:

• **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend including a bibliography of all course readings, as they find this can help students in understanding their assignments and what their expectations are.

Slavic 3800 was unanimously approved with one contingency and one recommendation:

- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty request that Student Life Disability Statement, as found on page 5 of the syllabus, be updated to the most up-to-date version. SLDS has not been located inside Pomerene Hall for several years and is now located in Baker Hall. The most up-to-date SLDS statement can be found on the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website at: https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty kindly suggest modifying the statement on page 3 of the syllabus that informs students they must be enrolled by the second full week of the semester, as it currently states that, "No requests to add the course will be approved by the Chair of the Department of History after that time".

Slavic 3340 will continue through the approval process and my office will advance the course to OAA while Slavic 3800 will be returned to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's feedback.
