On Wednesday, Feb. 22nd, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a course proposal for Physics 5810.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with one recommendation and one comment:

- a. Comment: The Panel offers a friendly reminder to the department that, per a decision of the ASCC, they cannot review Carmen sites or screen shots from Carmen due to issues of access and record keeping. While the Panel was able to approve this course based on the minimal schedule provided in the syllabus, in the future, they ask that the department refrain from submitting Carmen screen shots or links to Carmen in lieu of a syllabus or required syllabus elements.
- b. *Recommendation:* The Panel recommends that the department update the Mental Health Statement (syllabus pg. 10-11 under "Your Mental Health"), as there is a new phone number for the National Crisis/Suicide Hotline. The most up-to-date statement can be found here: https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements.
- c. Hamilton, Cole; unanimously approved with *one recommendation* (in italics above), and one comment.

As a reminder, recommendations (in italics above) should be implemented when the course is next taught. Comments require no action by the department at this time but may be useful for future submissions.

Physics 5810 will continue through the approval process to OAA; my office will advance the course.
