## Good afternoon,

On Thursday, September 22, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the proposal for Mathematics 2175. Please find below the Panel's feedback for this proposal. {N.B. **Contingencies (bolded)** require revision and resubmission to the Panel chair, while *recommendations (italicized)* or comments are suggestions from the Panel that an instructor can implement at their discretion when the course is taught.}

MATHEMATICS 2175 | Unanimously approved with five (5) recommendations

- RECOMMENDATION: The Panel recommends that the department communicate to any stakeholder units potentially affected by the advent of this new bridge class how this might change/realign the various sequences of courses students pursue to complete their degree requirements.
- RECOMMENDATION: The Panel recommends that the ways assigned readings (if any) fit into the course structure be more readily apparent in the syllabus document. If students are expected to read as part of homework even if this reading is embedded within an interactive electronic textbook the Panel suggests indicating this more explicitly re: what students can expect as part of their workload for the class.
- RECOMMENDATION: On page 2 of the syllabus, the Panel kindly notes that "midterm" and "review" appear to be in the incorrect/inverse columns on weeks 6 and 10 of the course schedule, and suggests revising this accordingly.
- RECOMMENDATION: The Panel recommends removing any reference to an "OSU standard grading scheme," as Ohio State does not have a standardized grading scheme.
- RECOMMENDATION: The Panel suggests that the department include the most up-todate version of the University's Title IX statement, which can be found here: https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements

Mathematics 2175 will continue through the approval process.
