Good morning,

On Tuesday, October 11th, the Themes 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed new GEN Theme: Traditions, Cultures, Transformations requests for History 3227 and 2401 and a new GEN Theme: Migration, Mobility and Immobility request for History 3070. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

History 3227 was unanimously approved with three contingencies and one recommendation:

- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that the GEL Goals and ELOs for which this course is approved be added to the course syllabus. As a reminder, History 3227 is approved for GEL Historical Study and GEL Diversity – Global Studies and the GEL Goals and ELOs can be found on the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website at: <https://ascas.osu.edu/legacy-general-education-gel-goals-and-elos>.
- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that a brief GE rationale paragraph be added underneath the GEL and GEN Goals and ELOs within the course syllabus that explains to students how they can expect to meet the GEL and GEN Goals and ELOs. This is a requirement of all GE courses within the College of Arts and Sciences.
- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that the GE submission form provide an answer to GEN ELO 1.2, as it is currently missing.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty kindly suggest to the department modifying their prerequisite of English 1110 to be "Completion of GE Foundation Writing and Information Literacy course", as English 1110 is not the only writing course available to students to take within the new GE program. Of course, the reviewing faculty recognize that some departments and programs may wish to keep their prerequisite of strictly English 1110 and merely offer this as a friendly suggestion.

History 3070 was unanimously approved with one contingency and one recommendation:

- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that the GEL Goals and ELOs for which this course is approved be added to the course syllabus and the GEN Goals and ELOs be updated, as not all GE ELOs are listed on the course syllabus. As a reminder, History 3070 is approved for GEL Historical Study and the GEL Goals and ELOs can be found on the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website at: <https://ascas.osu.edu/legacy-general-education-gel-goals-and-elos>, while the GEN Goals and ELOs can be found here: <https://ascas.osu.edu/new-general-education-gen-goals-and-elos>.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty kindly suggest to the department modifying their prerequisite of English 1110 to be "Completion of GE Foundation Writing and Information Literacy course", as English 1110 is not the only writing course available to students to take within the new GE program. Of course, the reviewing faculty recognize that some departments and programs may wish to keep their prerequisite of strictly English 1110 and merely offer this as a friendly suggestion.

History 2401 was unanimously approved with two contingencies and one recommendation:

- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that the correct GEL information for Historical Studies be added to the course syllabus. The correct GEL Historical Studies Goals and ELOs can be found on the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website at: <https://ascas.osu.edu/legacy-general-education-gel-goals-and-elos>. Additionally, they ask that the GEN Theme Goals be added to the course syllabus and a brief GE rationale be provided underneath that explains to students how they can expect to fulfill these GE Goals and ELOs, as a requirement of GE courses within the College of Arts and Sciences. - The reviewing faculty also ask that all references to the GEC be removed from the course syllabus, as that is not the correct General Education plan that the University is requiring students to be on. The GEC is a program that was discontinued in 2012.
- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that GEN ELO 1.2 be answered in the GE Theme submission forms, as it currently is missing.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty kindly suggest to the department modifying their prerequisite of English 1110 to be “Completion of GE Foundation Writing and Information Literacy course”, as English 1110 is not the only writing course available to students to take within the new GE program. Of course, the reviewing faculty recognize that some departments and programs may wish to keep their prerequisite of strictly English 1110 and merely offer this as a friendly suggestion.

I will return History 3227, 3070, and 2401 to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel’s feedback.
