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Good morning Beth and MaryKatherine,

Bill Putikka, faculty Chair of the ASCC Themes 2 Panel, and Maria Conroy, faculty Chair of the Theme Advisory Group: Sustainability, have reviewed the revision to English 3340.

Unfortunately, at this time, they find the revisions do not fully satisfy the Panel's feedback. Please see below for the remaining feedback that needs to be addressed:

• The revisions have not fully addressed the concerns of providing a clearer and more direct link to the idea of sustainability in the syllabus, and specifically, the course assignments. The reviewing faculty ask that more direct use of the language of sustainability (including the word sustainability itself) be woven into the course syllabus language and the assignments provide a more explicit connection to the idea of sustainability.

I will return English 3340 to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's remaining concerns above.

Good afternoon Beth and MaryKatherine,

On Tuesday, November 8th, the Themes 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed new GEN Theme: Sustainability requests for English 3340 & 3020. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

English 3340

The Panel unanimously approved the request with three contingencies and one recommendation:

- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that the course assignments more strongly connect to the GEN Theme: Sustainability. Neither the short projects nor the final project seems to have a connection to the Theme of Sustainability.
- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that GEN Theme Goals and ELOs be corrected in the course syllabus, as they are currently incorrect on the provided syllabus. A list of complete and easy to copy-and-paste Goals and ELOs can be found on the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website at: <u>https://asccas.osu.edu/new-general-education-gen-goals-and-elos</u>.
- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that a cover letter be provided that details all changes made as a result of this feedback.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend removing the reference to the OSU standard grading scale, as Ohio State does not have a standardized grading scale and the course instructor is free to use a grading scale that best suits the needs of their course.

English 3020

The Panel unanimously approved the request with one recommendation:

• **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend updating the prerequisite on the syllabus to match the updated prerequisite in curriculum.osu.edu.

I will return English 3340 to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's feedback above while English 3020 will continue through the approval process and my office will advance the request to OAA.
