ASC Curriculum Committee:

The Department of Mathematics is proposing to deactivate its Bachelor of Arts (BA) program in Actuarial Science at the conclusion of SP27 term. Here is the rationale behind the proposal with some comments.

- With the adoption of the NEW General Education requirements (effective AU22), there is currently no difference between the GE-NEW requirements for the BA in Actuarial Science and for the BS in Actuarial Science. For that reason, effective AU22, the Department of Mathematics is no longer accepting new students into the Bachelor of Arts (BA) program in Actuarial Science.  
Note: The Bachelor of Science (BS) program in Actuarial Science will continue.
- The SP27 deactivation date allows the existing BA GE-Legacy Actuarial Science majors in the current pipeline to finish their programs.
- This is a request to deactivate the BA in Actuarial Science rather than to withdraw it, as there may be future discussions about creating new policy to differentiate between the GE-New BA and the GE-New BS requirements for Actuarial Science.
