On Thursday, October 27th, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to revise the Campaigns and Elections Minor.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with one recommendation:

Recommendation: The Panel recommends that the department give careful consideration as to whether Political Science 4160 should be included as an elective choice for students in the minor given Prof. Kogan's statement that the differences between the 2150 (which is now required for all students) and 4160 "have largely disappeared over time."

The Campaigns and Elections minor revision will continue through the approval process.
