Good afternoon,

On Tuesday, December 6<sup>th</sup>, the Themes 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GEN Theme: Health and Wellbeing proposal for Philosophy 2465.

I am pleased to report that the Panel unanimously approved the request with two recommendations:

- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend providing a full bibliography of all course texts for students within the course syllabus.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend expanding the GE ELO rationale (as found on page 3 of the syllabus) to more thoroughly explain how the GE (both Legacy and New) ELOs will be fulfilled.

Philosophy 2465 will continue through the approval process. My office will advance the proposal to OAA.
