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Good morning Ila and Phoebe,

On Friday, January 27<sup>th</sup>, the Themes 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a GEN Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World request for Hebrew 3705. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

I am pleased to report that Hebrew 3705 was approved with two recommendations:

- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty kindly suggest to the department modifying their prerequisite of English 1110 to be "Completion of GE Foundation Writing and Information Literacy course", as English 1110 is not the only writing course available to students to take within the new GE program. Of course, the reviewing faculty recognize that some departments and programs may wish to keep their prerequisite of strictly English 1110 and merely offer this as a friendly suggestion.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty suggest removing all references to the outdated quarter system (as found on page 7 of the course syllabus) and replace this with semester.

Hebrew 3705 will continue through the approval process and my office will advance the course to OAA.
