On Wednesday, December 7<sup>th</sup>, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new cross-listed course proposal for Spanish/Comparative Studies/WGSS 2381.

- **Recommendation:** The Panel offers the friendly reminder to ensure that all standardized statements (such as Student Life Disability Services, Title IX, etc.), are updated for the campus where the course will be offered.
- **Recommendation:** The Panel recommends updating the absence policy regarding medical excuses, as Student Health Services no longer offers the self-identification of absence and is asking students to no longer schedule an appointment to obtain a medical excuse, especially when they can self-care at home.
