Good afternoon,

On Thursday, December 8, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed requests for Statistics 6910, 6950, 7301, 7302, 7410, 7541, & 8625. Please see below for the Panel's feedback on these proposals. {N.B. **Contingencies (bolded)** require revision and resubmission to the Panel chair, while *recommendations (italicized)* or comments are suggestions from the Panel that an instructor can implement at their discretion when the course is taught.}

STATISTICS 6910 | Approved

STATISTICS 6950 | Approved

STATISTICS 7301 | Approved

STATISTICS 7302 | Approved with **one (1) contingency** and *one (1) recommendation*

- **CONTINGENCY: The Panel requests that the course include the following exclusion on the curriculum.osu.edu form and the syllabus: “not open to students with credit for STATS 7303.”**
- *RECOMMENDATION: The Panel recommends including midterm dates and any other important benchmarks or deadline on the course calendar (beginning on page 4 of the syllabus).*

STATISTICS 7410 | Approved with one (1) comment

- **COMMENT:** The reviewing faculty offer a friendly reminder to review and revise any course technologies listed in the syllabus that might no longer be relevant when finalizing the document for a particular term.

STATISTICS 7541 | Approved with *one (1) recommendation*

- *RECOMMENDATION: The reviewing faculty recommend double-checking that the textbook list is up to date and corresponds with reading assignments included on the course calendar. At present, there is one required textbook listed on the syllabus that*

does not appear on the schedule (required textbook C, per page 2 of the document), so the Panel suggests either removing this book from the list if no longer needed, or adding readings from this textbook to the course calendar accordingly.

STATISTICS 8625 | Approved with *one (1) recommendation*

- *RECOMMENDATION: The Panel strongly recommends clarifying when/on what specific class meeting days each reading assignment is due (rather than listing weekly readings) as well as including midterm dates and any other important benchmarks or deadlines on the course calendar (beginning on page 5 of the syllabus).*

Statistics 6910, 6950, 7301, 7302, 7410, 7541, & 8625 will continue through the approval process.
