On Wednesday, February 1st, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed your proposal for a new first-year seminar, "Music and Social Justice".

I am happy to report that the proposal was unanimously approved by the faculty panel, with one contingency and two recommendations:

- **Contingency:** The Panel asks that a provided reading list (or, if appropriate, playlist) be added to the course syllabus, as a requirement for first-year seminars is to include a reading list within the provided syllabus.
- **Recommendation:** The Panel strongly recommends to the department of English that they send a friendly communication to the School of Music, informing them of this new first-year seminar, as it may be of interest to their faculty and students. The Director of Undergraduate Studies in the School of Music is David Hedgecoth.1.
- **Recommendation:** The Panel asks that, in the grading scale on page 2 of the syllabus, the grade of "NP" be removed. The grade of "NP" is not equivalent to a grade of "E" and is a special designation for students who elect to take a course as Pass (P) or Not Pass (NP).

Once a revision has been completed that incorporates the Panel's above feedback, please send the revised syllabus to me and I will work to ensure the seminar receives full approval.
