I hope this email finds you well! My office is taking care of some end-of-semester housekeeping, and we noticed a couple of small discrepancies in the embedded literacy requirements for the new Forensic Anthropology BS.

In the materials that were approved when the major was created, page 17 of the PDF lists ANTHROP 3504 as the required Embedded Literacy Technology requirement. However, in the supplied advising sheet (appendix A, on page 24 of the PDF), it seems to indicate that ANTHROP 2200 is being utilized to fulfill the Embedded Literacy Technology requirement.
