Good morning Jen and Birgitte,

On Thursday, March 23rd, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed new distance learning proposals for History 3620, 3561, and 3575. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

I am pleased to report that the Panel approved the request for 3620. They also approved the request for 3561 and 3575 with two recommendations:

- **Recommendation:** For History 3561, it appears as if the GEN Theme Citizenship Goals and ELOs may have been duplicated multiple times within the syllabus (on pages 3-9 of the provided syllabus). The Panel recommends that these duplications be removed and only one set of Goals, ELOs, and explanatory rationale remain within the syllabus for student clarity.
- **Recommendation:** The Panel recommends updating the Title IX statement in each syllabus (page 16 for 3561 and page 11 for 3575), as Kellie Brennan is no longer the Title IX coordinator. History 3620, 3561, & 3575 will all continue through the approval process. My office will advance the proposals to OAA.
