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Good morning Beth and MaryKatherine,

On Wednesday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course request for English 3000.

I am pleased to report that the proposal has been unanimously approved with one recommendation:

- **Recommendation:** The Panel recommends adding language to the course description in [curriculum.osu.edu](http://curriculum.osu.edu) that reflects the fact that this course will be a Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World GEN Theme course. They find it may be helpful to students to know upfront that the course will be centered around writing as social change and about civic empowerment and they also believe this may help strengthen the course's connection to the Theme holistically.

English 3000 will continue through the approval process. The proposal will next go to the ASCC Themes Panel to be reviewed for its requested GEN Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World.
