On Thursday, March 23rd, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a course proposal for Sociology 7770.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with two contingencies and one recommendation:

- a. **Contingency:** The Panel asks that the department include in the syllabus the full Academic Misconduct statement mandated by the Arts and Sciences Curriculum Committee. The statement is available in an easy-to-copy/paste format here: https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements.
- b. **Contingency:** The Panel asks that the department include in the syllabus the full Disability Services statement mandated by the Arts and Sciences Curriculum Committee. The statement is available in an easy-to-copy/paste format here: https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements.
- c. Recommendation: The Panel recommends that the department provide a more detailed description of the instructor's expectations of students surrounding in-class participation (syllabus pg. 3), given that participation makes up such a large portion of students' grades.

As a reminder, **contingencies** (in bold above) must be addressed and resubmitted via curriculum.osu.edu before a course can move forward in the approval process. *Recommendations* (in italics above) should be implemented when the course is next taught.
