On Friday, May 12th, the Themes 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GEN Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World and High-Impact Practice: Research & Creative Inquiry request for Philosophy 2332. Please see below for the Panel's feedback.

GEN Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World

I am pleased to report that the Panel unanimously approved the request with one comment:

- **Comment:** The reviewing faculty of the Theme Advisory Group would like to communicate to the department that they felt this proposal was excellent in meeting the GEN Theme ELOs.

High-Impact Practice: Research & Creative Inquiry

The Panel did not vote on the proposal at this time and asks that the following feedback be addressed:

- The reviewing faculty thank the department for their submission as a high-impact practice, but, at this time, do not find the proposal to meet the standards to be included within the category of Research & Creative Inquiry. They ask that more information be provided on the research that students are conducting within the course and how the discipline that is being engaged with defines research. As a reminder, students must engage with creating original research within the field to be considered a fit within this category.
- The reviewing faculty ask that a cover letter be submitted that details all changes made as a result of this feedback.

I will return Philosophy 2332 to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's feedback regarding the High-Impact Practice.
