On Wednesday, March 27th, the Themes I Subcommittee of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a course proposal for KNSISM 3100 to be included in the GEN Foundation: Lived Environments.

The Subcommittee unanimously approved the request with one contingency and one recommendation:

- Contingency: Changes in University policies recently (03-01-2024) required the Arts and Sciences Curriculum Committee to update the list of required syllabus statements for all syllabi to include a new statement on religious accommodations. The new version is a result of a directive by the Executive Vice President and Provost and can be found here on the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website. The reviewing faculty thank you replacing the previous statement found on pg. 8 of the syllabus.
- Recommendation: The reviewing faculty recommend that the department consider removing the ELO column from the chart on pgs. 5-6 of the syllabus. While they appreciate the detail provided for the faculty reviewers, they note that this column may make the table more difficult for students to digest.

As a reminder, **contingencies** (in bold above) must be addressed and resubmitted via curriculum.osu.edu <u>before</u> this course can move forward in the approval process to OAA. *Recommendations* (in italics above) should be implemented when the course is next taught. I will return KNSISM 3100 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Subcommittee's requests.
