On Tuesday, January 30th, the Arts and Humanities 1 Subcommittee of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to create a new certificate in Contemporary Art and Curatorial Practice.

I am pleased to report that the certificate has been unanimously approved with one comment, one contingency, and one recommendation:

- **Comment:** The Subcommittee notes that HISTART 8641 is still cross-listed with COMPSTD 8891. However, COMPSTD 8891 has been withdrawn and is no longer a course. The Subcommittee asks that the unit submit a course change request via curriculum.osu.edu for HISTART 8641 and remove the cross-listing.
- **Contingency:** The Subcommittee asks that the unit seek concurrence from the Department of Arts Administration, Education, and Policy (AAEP).
- **Recommendation:** On the right-hand side of the advising sheet, there is still a reference to the certificate's old title of "Curatorial Studies". The Subcommittee recommends removing this reference for clarity.

I will return the certificate to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Subcommittee's feedback.
