On Tuesday, January 30<sup>th</sup>, the Arts and Humanities 1 Subcommittee of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course proposal for History of Art 7190.

I am pleased to report that the Subcommittee unanimously approved the request with one contingency and two recommendations:

- **Contingency:** The Arts and Sciences Curriculum Committee recently updated their list of required syllabus statements for all syllabi within the College to include a statement on religious accommodations. This new, required statement is a result of a directive by the Executive Vice President and Provost and [can be found here on the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website](#). The Subcommittee thanks you for adding this statement to your course syllabus.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty offer the friendly recommendation to update the Student Life – Disability Services statement in the course syllabus, as they recently updated it for the 2023-24 academic year, and the Mental Health statement. - **Recommendation:** The Subcommittee asks that, as part of seeking concurrence for the Graduate Certificate in Contemporary Art and Curatorial Practice, the department inform Arts Administration, Education, and Policy about this new course.
