On Monday, February 19th, the Themes II Subcommittee of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GEN Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World request for History 3281.

I am pleased to report that the Subcommittee unanimously approved the proposal with one comment and one recommendation:

- **Comment:** The reviewing faculty would like to let the course proposer know that they find this course to be an excellent proposal for the GEN Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend that the course title, on page 1 of the syllabus, be placed into a more accessible font in order to be clearer for students and align with best practices.

History 3281 will continue through the approval process. My office will advance the proposal to OAA.

Additionally, the reviewing faculty would like to utilize this course as an exemplar on the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website to serve as an example of a high-quality course within the GEN Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World category. In order to do this, I would need the permission of the course proposer and of the department (typically in the form of Director of Undergraduate Studies).
