On Thursday, October 24th, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Subcommittee of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course request for Earth Sciences 5201.

I am pleased to report that the Subcommittee approved the request with the following feedback:

- Contingency: The Subcommittee requests that the prerequisite and course description sections in the syllabus (p. 1) and curriculum.osu.edu be adjusted to reflect the following concise language (note that ASCCAS staff will work with the School in order to make these changes without delaying the approval process):
 - Prerequisites: Math through Calculus III (MATH 2153) or graduate standing or permission of the instructor. Recommended: Math 2168 or experience with linear algebra.
 - Add to the course description: A working knowledge of Python (preferred) or Matlab is necessary for successful completion of the course.

The course can either be returned to the School queue in curriculum.osu.edu to address this issue, or the ASC Office of Curriculum and Assessment can communicate with the School to take care of this without exchanging the course back and forth between queues. <u>Please let me know how you would like to proceed.</u>
