Good morning,

On Friday, April 18th, the Themes II Subcommittee of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new Theme: Migration, Mobility, and Immobility request for Classics 3230.

At this time, the Subcommittee declined to vote on the proposal and would like to see the following feedback addressed in a revision:

- The reviewing faculty would like to see a further integration of the Theme: Migration, Mobility, and Immobility within the course structure. They are unable to see where students will engage with the Theme in the course assignments and assessments (as presented in the materials submitted). Additionally, they would like to see more information on how the visits to the Museum of Classical Archaeology will afford students an opportunity to engage with the Theme.
- The reviewing faculty were unable to see how ELO 2.2 will be met within the course. They would like to see additional opportunities for students to self-reflect upon their experiences within the Theme woven throughout the course and in the course assignments/assessments.
- The reviewing faculty ask that a cover letter be submitted that details all changes made as a result of their feedback.

I will return the request via curriculum.osu.edu to allow you to address this feedback.
