Good morning,

On Tuesday, January 20th, the Arts and Humanities Subcommittee 2 of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course request for Russian 3106.

The Subcommittee approved the request with the following feedback:

- Comment: The Subcommittee notes that curriculum.osu.edu still lists Russian 2104.51 twice under the prerequisites. With the permission of the department, ASCCAS staff can update this entry to reflect the correct course number.
- *Recommendation:* Given that AI engagement is central to the course, the Subcommittee recommends considering additional assessment mechanisms to more explicitly evaluate students' use of and reflection on AI across assignments.
- *Recommendation:* The Subcommittee recommends incorporating AI audit trails as part of the course assignments. Requiring students to describe and reflect on their AI usage would promote transparency and deepen students' engagement with the AI-focused goals of the course.

As a reminder, *recommendations* (in italics above) should be implemented when the course is next taught.

Russian 3106 will continue through the approval process to OAA.
