## Good afternoon,

On Tuesday, November 25<sup>th</sup>, the Arts and Humanities Subcommittee 1 of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course request for Philosophy 3341.

I am pleased to report that the Subcommittee approved the request with the following feedback:

- Recommendation: The Subcommittee notes that the SLDS statement appears twice in the syllabus and recommends removing the version on pp. 6-7, as it is not the most recent version of the statement.
- Recommendation: The Subcommittee notes that the syllabus (pp. 6, 7-8) includes two
  academic misconduct statements and recommends removing one to avoid
  redundancy.
- Recommendation: The Subcommittee recommends that the department ensure the links included in the Religious Accommodations statement in the syllabus (p. 8) function as hyperlinks.
- Recommendation: The Subcommittee recommends removing the reference to the OSU
  grade scheme from the syllabus (p. 10), as OSU does not have a standardized grading
  scale and instructors are free to select a grading scheme which best suits the needs of
  their course.

As a reminder, *recommendations* (in italics above) should be implemented when the course is next taught.

Philosophy 3341 will continue through the approval process to OAA.
