Students minoring in Art are required to complete either Drawing- Art 205 or Visual Studies 2D- Art 206 plus an additional 15 credit hours selected from Department of Art courses. A maximum of 15 hours of 200 level courses may count towards the Minor. Any art course where prerequisites are waived by the instructor may be used, admission to these classes depends on space available. The following courses are grouped by area focus. Most have no, or minimal, prerequisites and are appropriate for selection by students in the Art Minor. Courses marked by an asterisk need permission of instructor.

A student who completes the minor following these guidelines must submit the College of Arts and Sciences Minor Program Form to a College of Arts and Sciences counselor. Variation from the program needs approval of the Chair of the Department of Art.

Arts and Sciences Minor Program guidelines:

Required for graduation No

Credit hours required Minimum of 20

Transfer credit hours permitted Maximum of 10

Overlap with GEC Permitted

Overlap with the major Not Allowed and

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major
- The same courses cannot count on the minor and on the major

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor program
- Minimum 2.0 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor
- Coursework graded Pass/Non-pass cannot count on the minor

Approval required The minor program description sheet indicates if the minor course work must be approved by:

- The academic unit offering the minor, or
- A college / school counselor

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed in the student's college office by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college / school counselor

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes or substitutions must be approved by the Department of Art Chair
