In response to the expanding vision of the Korean Undergraduate Major Program, the East Asian Master's Degree Program, and the University's vision for curricular diversity, Korean 655 is proposed to flexibly provide an interdisciplinary Korean studies course in the areas of art. There are very few courses in Korean art on campus, and Korean 655 will add a new and exciting dimension to the Arts and Sciences vision of diversity.
